### **Decision Making Tools**

#### 1. Four-Way Test

- Actions are rooted in truth, fairness, and mutual benefit
- By focusing on goodwill & fairness, encourages actions that build strong relationships

#### 2. New York Times Test

- Make decisions we feel comfortable sharing in public
- Choose options that reflect our values and maintains trust/credibility

#### 3. STAR Model Test

- Forces us to slow down and ensure decisiona are made with care and consideration rather than under pressure
- Encourage ongoing learning and improvement by evaluating our past decisions

#### **Decision Making Tools**

#### Four-Way Test

- Is it True
- Is it Fair to all Concerned
- Will it build Goodwill and Better Friendships
- Will it be Beneficial to all concerned

#### **New York Times Test**

Would I be comfortable if my decision or action were reported on the front page of the New York
Times for everyone to see?

Promote Transparency: Would you feel comfortable telling your mom or other person you care for?

Encourage Ethical Choices: What would your neighbors say?




## **Decision Making Tools**



#### STAR Model Test

- S Stop: Pause before making a decision to avoid acting impulsively
- T Think: Reflect on the options, consequences, and ethical considerations
- $A-\mbox{Act: }\mbox{Make a thoughtful, ethical decision based on the information gathered}$
- $R-\mbox{Reflect:}$  After the decision, review the outcome to learn from the experience
