How Are Stormwater Ponds and Restored Streams Treating Phosphorus in Urban Watersheds

Debabrata Sahoo, Associate Professor, Department of Agricultural Sciences, College of Agricultural, Forestry and Life Sciences, Clemson University

Parts of South Carolina are among the fastest-growing regions in the U.S. Terrestrial disturbances, such as urbanization, have the potential to significantly disrupt both biotic and abiotic biogeochemical processes, as well as alter the hydrologic behavior of watersheds and the receiving water bodies. These changes, in turn, have profound implications for downstream ecology, water quantity and water quality, particularly in nutrient — nitrogen and phosphorus — cycling. Dr. Sahoo will address the fate and transport of phosphorus in various coastal stormwater ponds and in urban restored and unrestored stream sites, exploring their implications for water resources, and outlining the next steps.
